

Creation story. AT1A AT2F.

Re-tell the Christian Creation story; explore how this influences how Christians behave towards nature and the world. **Christmas – Incarnation AT1A AT2D.** Learn to reflect on the Christmas story and decide what gifts would be meaningful for Jesus.

What did Jesus teach? AT1A AT2F

Learn to re-tell Bible stories that show kindness, and to explore how this makes Christians behave towards other people. **Christmas: Jesus as a gift from God AT1A AT2E** Learn to reflect on the Christmas story and the reasons for Jesus' birth.

Year 1

Jesus as a friend. AT1A AT2D.

Identify when it is easy and difficult to show friendship and explore when Jesus may have found it difficult.

Easter – Palm Sunday AT1A AT1 C AT2E

To know that Jesus is special to Christians and how his welcome on Palm Sunday shows this.

Shabbat. AT1B AT2D.

Empathise with Jewish children by understanding what they do during Shabbat and why it is important.

Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur. AT1B AT2D

Empathise with Jewish children by understanding what Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur mean to them.

Year 2

Prayer at home. AT1B AT2F

Explain what commitment means to us and to Muslims by knowing about how Muslims pray 5 times a day.

Easter Resurrection AT1A AT2E

Re-tell the Easter story and understand what Jesus' resurrection means for Christians. How important is it that Jesus came back to life?

Year 4

Belief into Action AT1B AT1C AT2F. Compare different ways Sikhs put their religion into practice.

Christmas AT1 A AT2 E

Evaluate different accounts of the Christmas story; understand stories can be true in different ways.

The Life of Buddha AT1B AT2F

Learn how Buddha's teachings make a difference to how Buddhists choose.

Christmas - Incarnation AT1C AT2E

What is the most significant part of the Nativity story for Christians today?

Understand the symbolism in the Christmas story and think about what the different parts mean to Christians today.

Passover AT1B AT2F

How special is the relationship Jews have with God? Understand how celebrating Passover and keeping Kashrut (food laws) help Jews show God they value their special relationship with him.

Hajj AT1B AT2F

Understand what happens during Hajj; explore the importance of this to Muslims. Does completing Hajj make a person a better Muslim?

Beliefs and morals AT1A AT1C AT2F

Learn to understand the relevance of Sikh stories today.

Easter AT1A AT2E. Question if God intended Jesus to be crucified or if Jesus' crucifixion was the consequence of events.

Year 5

Beliefs and moral values. AT1B AT2E Understand the impact of certain beliefs on a Hindu's life.

Beliefs and Practices: AT1B AT2F

Understand how Christians show their commitment to God and to evaluate if there is a best way.

Passover AT1B AT2E Understand how celebrating Passover and keeping Kashrut help Jews show God they value their relationship with him.

Easter AT1A AT2E Understand how Jesus' life, death and resurrection teaches Christians about forgiveness.

Divali AT1B AT1C AT2D. Investigate what happens during the festival of Divali and whether the celebrations bring a sense of belonging to Hindus.

Christmas AT1A AT2E Find out what the true meaning of Christmas is to Christians and compare this with what Christmas means to us.

Year 3

Jesus' miracles AT1A AT2E

To retell Bible stories when miracles have happened And question whether Jesus really.

Easter – forgiveness. AT1C AT2E

Recall key events in the Easter story and understand why Jesus' crucifixion symbolises hope for Christians.

Year 6

Beliefs and practices AT1B AT2F understand the ways Muslims show commitment to God; evaluate whether there is a best way. **Christmas AT1A AT2E** Evaluate different Christmas traditions and celebrations in the light of their relevance to Christian beliefs in Jesus.

Beliefs and Practices. AT1 B AT2 F

Understand how Buddha's teachings make a difference to how Buddhists.

Christmas. Prayers and Worship AT1B AT2 D

Understand how important going to church is to show someone.

Sharing and community AT1B AT2E

Explore how Sikh beliefs affect their way of life and the importance they place on sharing.

Pilgrimage to the River Ganges AT1C AT2F

Understand the significance of the River Ganges both for a Hindu and a non-Hindu. **OR**

Belief and meaning. AT1A AT2E

Evaluate different beliefs about eternity; understand the Christian perspective on this.

Easter AT1B AT1D AT2E

Examine the influences Christianity still has in the world; evaluate whether it is still a strong religion.

Beliefs and moral values. AT1A

AT2D AT2E. Identify ways in which Muslims lead good lives and how their belief in Akhirah influences. Challenge stereotyping through understanding different Muslim interpretations of Jihad and how this links to getting to Heaven.
